

Take & Make: Paper Star

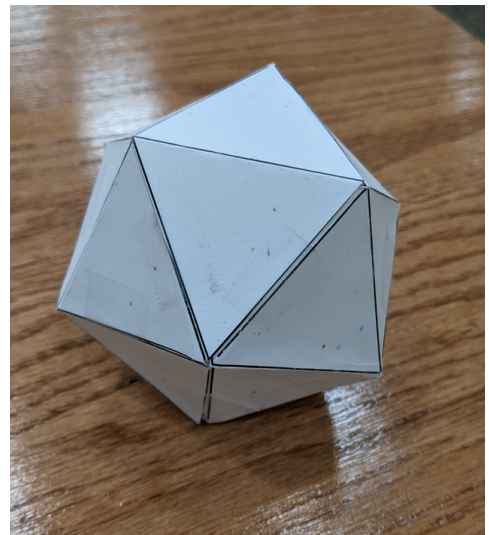
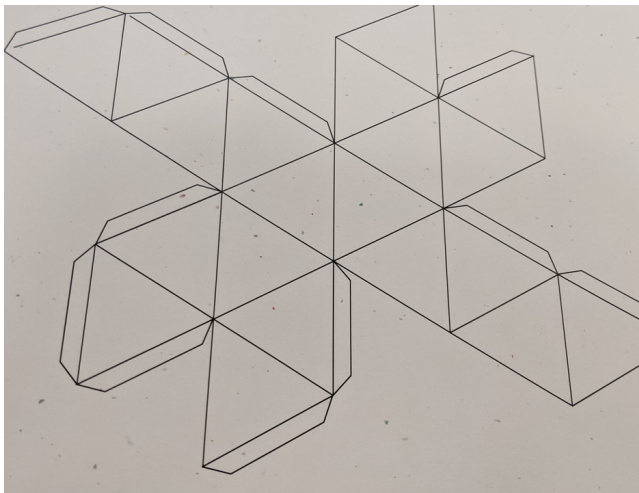
Supplies:

- Glue, Scissors, pen, ruler
- Star body template
- Star point template
- Book pages
- Plenty of patience - this takes a while



Cut out the star body, fold and glue closed.

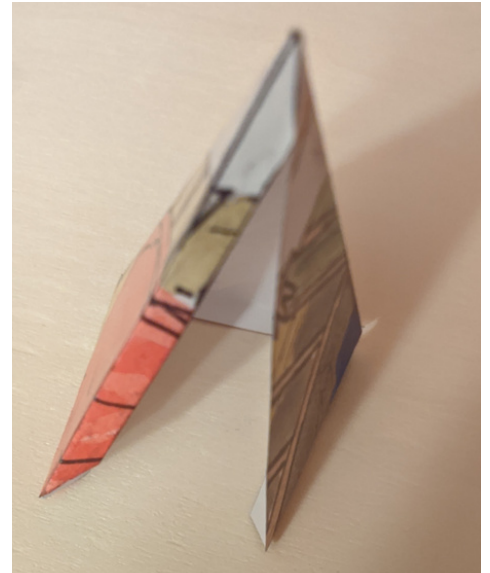
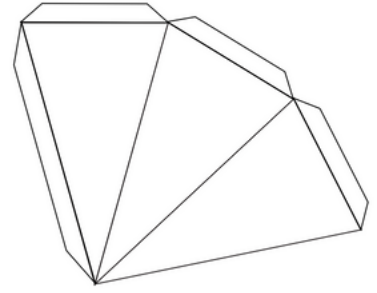
- Cardstock, a cereal box or light cardboard work best for the body.
- Scoring the lines with a pen before folding helps hugely.
- White glue (Elmer's style glue) works best for this step.

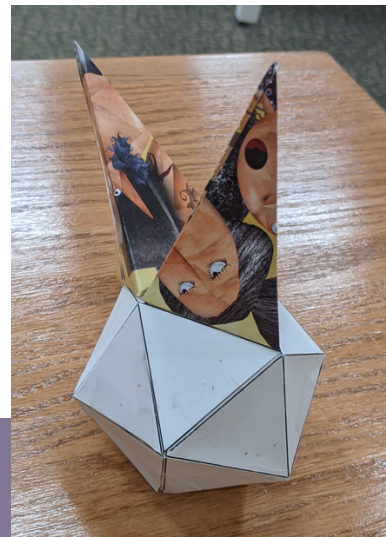
Make 20 star points.

- Cut out the star point template.
- Trace the template onto book pages or any suitable paper.
- Use a ruler to draw in fold lines. Scoring the lines helps folding.
- Cut out and fold each star point closed.
- Glue along long edge and let dry.
- I found that a glue stick works best for this step.



Glue star points to star body.

- Glue a few points to the body.
- Allow to dry before adding more.
- White glue works well, but a heated glue gun may also work.
- Be PATIENT
